Outsource SMART was a proud contributor to the handing over of a teachers training facility in Oukasie, an under privileged community of the North West province. The facility is housed in the Hectorex community training centre, on the outskirts of Brits.

The Deputy Minister of education Mr. Mohamed Enver Surty, and North West Education MEC, Louisa Mabe were in attendance. In addition there were representatives from the national, regional and district department of education and the district mayor.

Over ninety teachers from Botlhabelo, Odi and Kutlwano primary schools will benefit from the interactive and collaborative learning environment for the next generation classroom.
